**A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, by sub-section (1) of section 47 of the Constitution of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (Cap. 10 of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Revised Edition, 2009), it is provided that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Saint Vincent and the Grenadines and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall appoint by Proclamation;

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient that a session of the said Parliament shall be held at the Temporary Parliament Building in Glen, Saint George, and shall begin on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2023 at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon:

**NOW THEREFORE, I DAME SUSAN DOUGAN, GCMG, OBE**, Governor-General of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, do hereby appoint the said Temporary Parliament Building in Glen, Saint George as the place at which the said session shall be held on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2023 at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon as the time at which the said session shall begin.

**GIVEN** Under my hand and the Public Seal of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines this 11<sup>th</sup> day of December, Two thousand and twenty-three and in the Second year of the reign of His Majesty **KING CHARLES THE THIRD**.
