MOTION

1*. 2012 ESTIMATES OF ST. VINCENT & THE GRENADINES

To be moved by Dr. the Honourable Ralph Gonsalves, Prime Minister/Minister of Finance.

WHEREAS Section 70 (1) of the Constitution of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines provides that the Minister for the time being responsible for finance shall cause to be prepared and laid before the House of Assembly before, or not later than thirty days after, the commencement of each financial year estimates of the revenues and expenditure of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines for that financial year;

AND WHEREAS Section 70 (2) of the Constitution provides for the approval of the estimates of expenditure by the House;

AND WHEREAS the Government had additionally decided to prepare estimates on a triennial basis.

BE IT RESOLVED that this Honourable House of Assembly do adopt the Estimates for the financial year ending 31st December, 2012.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Honourable House note the projections for the financial years ending 31st December, 2013 and 31st December, 2014.

RESOLUTION

The Honourable Minister of Finance to move:

BE IT RESOLVED that this Honourable House do authorise the Minister of Finance to borrow by means of fluctuating overdraft or otherwise from First Caribbean International Bank or the RBTT Bank Caribbean Ltd. or the Bank of Nova Scotia, or the Bank of St. Vincent Grenadines Ltd., money to an amount not exceeding in the aggregate thirty-five million dollars, during the period 1st January, 2012 to 31st December, 2012 for the purpose of meeting the current requirements of the Government.
