A PROCLAMATION



DAME SUSAN DOUGAN, GCMG, OBE, GOVERNOR-GENERAL

WHEREAS, by sub-section (1) of section 47 of the Constitution of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (Cap. 10 of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Revised Edition, 2009), it is provided that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Saint Vincent and the Grenadines and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall appoint by Proclamation;

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient that a session of the said Parliament shall be held upstairs of the Court House building, Kingstown, and shall begin on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022 at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon:

**NOW THEREFORE, I DAME SUSAN DOUGAN, GCMG, OBE,** Governor-General of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, do hereby appoint the said upstairs of the Court House Building as the place at which the said session shall be held on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022 at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon as the time at which the said session shall begin.
